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<b>Date</b>	July 26, 2008 (Saturday)
<b>Overview</b>	The prime focus of Crisis Management and Emergency Management is on safety of people and assets. Simulating real-life, participants in this interactive workshop react to crisis situations as they unfold, experience first-hand the challenges of Emergency Response and gain an appreciation of the critical need for proactive planning, exercising and maintenance. The exercise debrief encapsulates the learnings and help participants to ensure effective implementation back at their workplace.
<b>Crisis Scenario</b>	Bomb Explosion
<b>Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimize risk to your company and resources when disaster strikes</li> <li>• Operate a command centre and recover quickly</li> <li>• Document, track, monitor and control events and actions taken</li> <li>• Effectively manage crisis communications with external and internal agencies, and the public</li> <li>• Familiarize and prepare staff to react quickly, decisively.</li> <li>• Gain an appreciation of the criticality of Crisis Management, and its key drivers</li> </ul>
<b>Structure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants are divided into teams of 6-8.</li> <li>• Each participant assumes the role of a crisis management team member (e.g. physical security head, BC manager)</li> <li>• Crisis incidents are unfolded to all the teams simultaneously, in a cascading manner; to which they need to respond to</li> <li>• Incidents are communicated through physically handing over slips or news flashes on the screen</li> <li>• Post the simulation exercise a de-briefing session is conducted by the instructor, encapsulating the learnings</li> </ul>
<b>Target Audience</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Crisis Management team members, and all personnel involved in Emergency Response</li> <li>• Managers responsible for Risk Management, Physical Security, Facilities, HR and Administration</li> <li>• Managers of any large office or operating facility</li> <li>• Members of the BCM Team, department BCM coordinators, recovery and support team members</li> <li>• External and internal auditors</li> </ul>
